- JUNE 17** Military and overseas ballots mailed.
- JULY 13** Ballots mailed to domestic voters (in the United States).
- JULY 25** Deadline for online and mail-in voter registrations and updates.
- AUGUST 2** Deadline to return ballots for this election. Ballots must be postmarked no later than Election Day or placed in an official ballot drop box by 8:00 p.m. on Election night.
- AUGUST 16** Election certified by Canvassing Board.  
**Office Hours:** M–F, 8:30 a.m.—4:30 p.m.  
**Election Day Hours:** 8:30 a.m.—8:00 p.m.  
**Express Vote:** A touch screen voting unit which allows persons to vote without assistance. Available from the date the ballots are mailed during hours listed above.
