- JUNE 17** Military and overseas ballots mailed.
- JULY 13** Ballots mailed to domestic voters (in the United States).
- JULY 25** Deadline for online and mail-in voter registrations and updates.
- AUG 2** Deadline to return ballots for this election. Ballots must be postmarked no later than election day or placed in an official ballot drop box by 8:00 p.m. on election night.
- AUG 16** Election certified by Canvassing Board.
